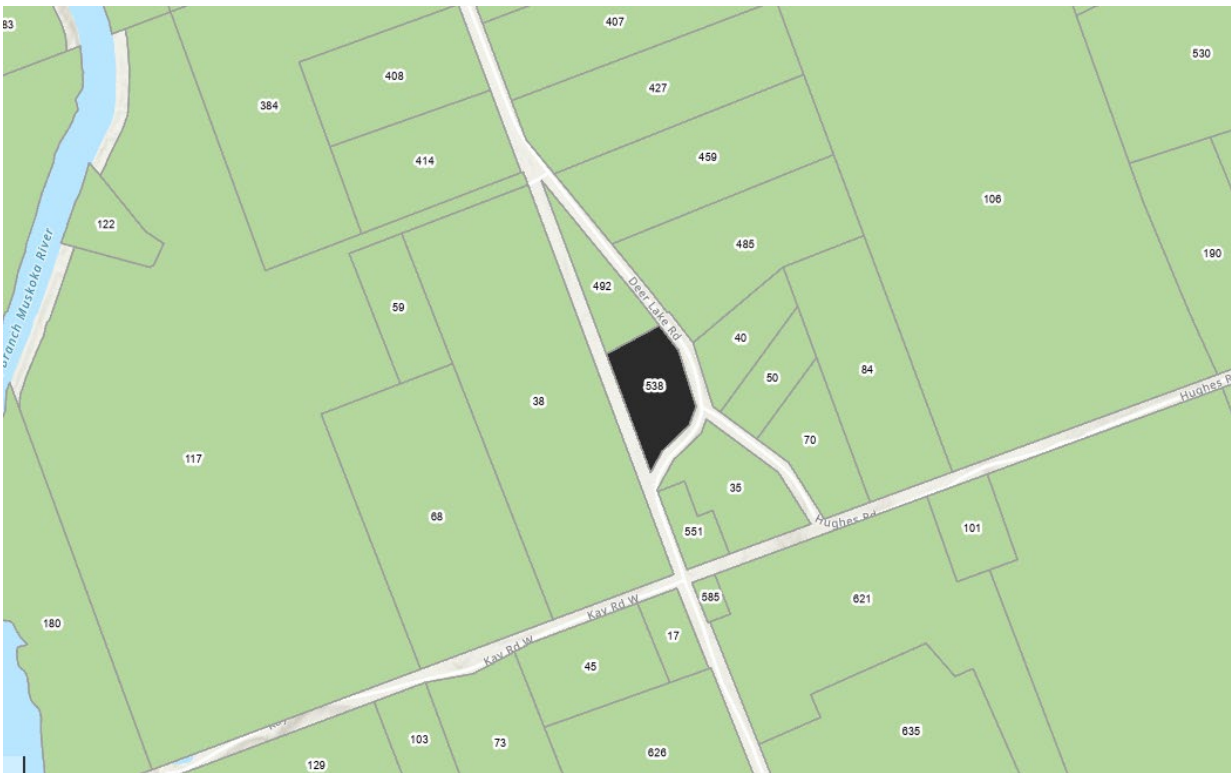

ADDRESS: 538 Deer Lake Road

LEGAL DESCRIPTION: Part of Lot 26, Concession 3; Former Geographic Township of Stephenson; Designated as Part 2 on Plan 35R-8864; Town of Huntsville; District Municipality of Muskoka

PURPOSE AND EFFECT: The applicant is proposing a lot addition. An area of approximately 0.2 ha is proposed to be severed from 538 Deer Lake Road and added to 492 Deer Lake Road. The retained lands are proposed to have an area of approximately 1.1 ha with 187 m of frontage along Deer Lake Road. No new lots are being created through this application.



A decision on this application will be made **NO EARLIER THAN Thursday, June 11th, 2026**. Any submissions regarding this application must be made in writing before this date.

Any person or public body may make written submissions to the Town of Huntsville concerning the proposed consent application. ***Please take note that any objections must include your name, contact information and reasons for your objection.***

ALL COMMENTS AND SUBMISSIONS RECEIVED will become part of the public record. Comments received as part of the public participation process for this proposal will be considered by the approval authority.

IF YOU WISH TO BE NOTIFIED of the decision of the Town of Huntsville in respect of the proposed consent, you must make a written request to the Planning Department (see address below).

IF AN INDIVIDUAL, SPECIFIED PERSON OR PUBLIC BODY files an appeal of a decision of the Town of Huntsville in respect of the proposed consent to the Ontario Land Tribunal but does not make written submissions to the Town of Huntsville before it gives or refuses to give a provisional consent, the Tribunal may dismiss the appeal.
