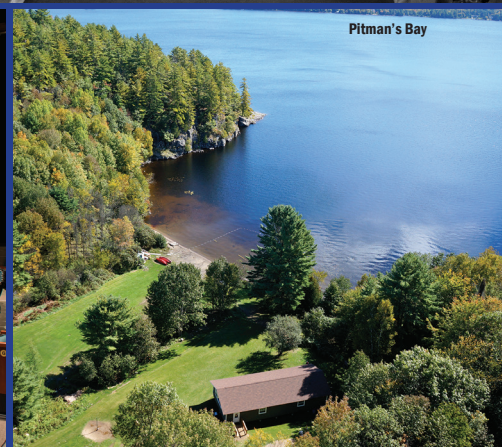

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CANADA SUMMIT CENTRE

20 Park Drive, Huntsville



The Canada Summit Centre is a year-round multipurpose venue showcasing various spaces, including the Active Living Centre.

DON LOUGH ARENA

- Olympic-sized ice surface – 100' x 200'
- Maximum capacity – 2,200, includes wheelchair-accessible location and standing room
- Seating Capacity – 1,371
- Removable glass and boards for events
- Sound system
- Upper/lower warm viewing areas
- Four-sided score clock with wireless control
- Indoor rubberized walking track on upper level
- Five large dressing rooms

JACK BIONDA ARENA

- Ice surface – 85' x 190'
- Maximum capacity – 1,000, includes wheelchair-accessible location and standing room
- Indoor warm viewing area
- Seven dressing rooms of various sizes

CENTENNIAL POOL

There are three pools at the Centennial Pool

- Large pool – 25 meter, 6 lanes
- Small pool – gradual levels with whirlpool jets – 93°F – 94°F
- Spa pool – hot tub pool – 100°F

- Al Thorpe – 19'x13'
- Peter Jacob – 17'x13'

INDOOR TRACK

The indoor track is available on a drop-in basis whenever the Canada Summit Centre is open. When a private or ticketed event is taking place the walking track is not available. The indoor track is approximately five laps to the kilometre.



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ACTIVE LIVING CENTRE

20 Park Drive, Huntsville



Adjacent to the Canada Summit Centre, the Active Living Centre is the perfect venue for a multitude of events. This facility has over 14,000 square feet of unique space for special events and functions. The main floor is a distinctive space with a majestic stone fireplace and large windows overlooking the picturesque Muskoka River.

This location offers numerous opportunities for different events; meetings and conferences, team-building activities, banquets, seminars, weddings, receptions and more. It is conveniently located close to Lions Lookout, The Portage Flyer Train and Muskoka Heritage Place. Small meeting rooms for smaller functions are also available.

ACTIVE LIVING CENTRE AMENITIES

- Room capacity – 300 (based on set-up)
- 14,000 square feet on two floors
- Flexible space – main floor room has portable wall enabling two smaller meeting rooms
- Small meeting rooms

PORT SYDNEY COMMUNITY HALL 607 Muskoka Road 10, Port Sydney



- Capacity = 221
- Full kitchen facility, including place settings of china and cutlery for 221
- Stage
- 60-foot deck stretches along the front of the building for superb view of Mary Lake
- Available for meetings, weddings, dances, programs, classes and community events.

UTTERSON / STEPHENSON COMMUNITY HALL 32 Township Hall Road, Utterson



- Capacity = 150
- Air conditioned
- Full kitchen facility, including glass and stemware, place settings of china and cutlery for 150
- Stage
- Green space adjacent to the hall available with hall rental
- Meeting room available for smaller groups
- Available for leisure activities, musical performances, family parties, wedding receptions, business meetings, service club dinners, exercise activities (fitness and yoga), band rehearsals, auctions, dances, religious gatherings and more.



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ATHLETIC FIELDS & RECREATION

Huntsville's outstanding green space, waterfront parks, trails and playgrounds offer ideal locations throughout the town for quiet relaxation and events. Whether you are paddling down a river, relaxing in a Muskoka chair or participating in a sporting event, Huntsville has lots of locations and facilities to choose from.

CONROY PARK 120 Brunel Road and 20 Forbes Hill Drive, Huntsville



Conroy Park was designed with healthy and active lifestyles in mind. This outdoor facility offers a professional grade rubberized running track, an artificial turf field that includes standards for field lacrosse and soccer, and two tennis courts. Its convenient location within walking distance to the Canada Summit Centre and Huntsville High School make this an excellent location to host outdoor events.

- Artificial turf field – suitable for soccer or lacrosse
- Eight-lane 400 metre rubberized surface track
- Two tennis courts and practice wall
- Accessible washrooms onsite

McCULLEY ROBERTSON RECREATION PARK 300 William Street, Huntsville



McCulley Robertson Complex has soccer pitches, baseball diamonds, a skateboard park, Disc Golf course and a leash-free dog park. This complex sees numerous tournaments and special events, especially during the summer months.

SOFTBALL: Three softball diamonds • Lights and fencing

HARDBALL: One hardball diamond • Lights and fencing

SOCCER: Three soccer pitches

ROTARY SKATEBOARD PARK: Skateboard park

DISC GOLF COURSE: Disc Golf is a growing sport loved by Frisbee fans. This 18-hole course allows for self-participation during daylight hours.

FREEDOM DOG PARK: Fenced-in area allows for off-leash play for pooches. Two fenced-in enclosures to safely accommodate both large and small dogs.

A year-round park in the heart of Muskoka where you can hike or bicycle on trails that meander through maple forests and past waterfalls, beaver ponds and homesteaders' farms.




