Subject: **IMPORTANT – VOTER INFORMATION LETTERS**

Date: Friday, October 8, 2010

On Thursday, October 7, 2010 it was brought to the attention of the Returning Officer for the Town of Huntsville Municipal Election that a problem occurred with some of the Voter Information Letters that were mailed out the week of October 4, 2010.

The Town of Huntsville was advised by the company retained to conduct the electronic voting method for the 2010 Municipal Election, Intelivote Systems Inc., that the information letters were folded by a subcontractor using an incorrect folding method, a “C” fold rather than a “Z” fold. The resulting fold did not adequately obscure the PIN when it was inserted in the envelope, as is required when mailing out confidential information in this format.

This error was reported by the Election Official of the Town of Huntsville to Intelivote Systems Inc., and the changes and re-mailing are being made at the Town’s direction and at no additional cost to the Town of Huntsville.

The personal identification numbers contained within the original circulation have been disabled and replacement Voter Information Letters will be mailed out by the end of the day, Friday, October 8, 2010.
